As you will be aware term ends on Thursday 21st July. We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for all of your support this academic year. We would also like to share with you some important information on your child's return to school in September. The table below shows the date and time that each year group will be returning.

All year groups will attend an assembly with Mr Singh on their return to school. Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time, in the correct uniform and ready to learn.

From Thursday 8th September, all pupils are expected to be in school and on site for 8.40am, ready for form time at 8.45am. If your child is not in form at 8.45am then they are marked as late.

At Queensbridge we value the importance of our school uniform and we hold high standards and expectations. Pupils are expected to wear the correct uniform and have the correct equipment at all times. Pupils who do not follow the policy will be challenged by their form tutor. On a daily basis, the form tutor will check uniform and equipment every morning and will inform your child's Head of Year before 9.00am if any pupil has not met our expectations. Parents will be contacted to bring the correct items into school. Please can we ask that parents/carers engage with the uniform and

equipment list on our school website and take note of the information below to enable a smooth and effective return to school for all pupils in September.

Uniform

- School trousers must be navy blue. **Black trousers are not permitted.**
- Appropriate length Navy Blue Skirt. **Lycra and/or pencil skirts are not permitted.**
- School shoes should be formal all-black polishable shoes. **Black Nike Air Force One trainers (and other similar brand) are not permitted as school shoes. Boots are also not permitted as school shoes.**
- Hoodies/tracksuit tops/branded sweatshirts are not a replacement for the school jumper and should not be worn anywhere on the school site.
- Smart Watches and synthetic nails are not allowed in school.
- Only one pair of stud earrings are allowed, no cuff piercings or nose studs.
- No mobile phones are permitted anywhere on school site.

We have attached the uniform requirements to the bottom of this letter with some examples of acceptable and unacceptable footwear.

Dance lessons only

Dance kit – QB tracksuit bottoms or dance leggings with QB PE top, long or short sleeve. (All can be purchased from our uniform suppliers). The official QB dance kit should be worn only on days when your child has dance.

On the day where your child has Physical Education they **must** come to school in their **full school uniform** and bring their correct PE kit for this lesson in a bag. Please note that hoodies or additional sportswear are not permitted on site and are not part of Dance or PE equipment.

Equipment

In September, all pupils should have a school bag with a pencil case that contains blue, black and green pens, pencils, sharpener, ruler, eraser, calculator, glue stick and a highlighter. For DT, pupils will require a navy blue apron.

| <p>Uniform requirements for ALL pupils</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Dark navy V neck jumper with 'Q' logo. ➤ Pale blue polo shirt (long or short sleeves) with 'Q' logo. ➤ Navy blue formal full-length trousers (no lycra or cropped allowed). Black trousers are not permitted. ➤ Appropriate length Navy Blue skirt, or long navy skirt (no lycra/pencil skirts allowed). ➤ Formal all black shoes that can be polished, without colours or logos. ➤ If worn with skirts, white, blue or black socks, ankle or just below knee height. ➤ Hair accessories must be blue or black if worn. ➤ Hair must be a natural colour. ➤ Navy blue head scarf. |
| <p>PE</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ AKOA PE kit. ➤ A polo top with 'Q' logo on. ➤ A choice of plain dark blue tracksuit bottoms, or skorts, with 'Q' logo on. ➤ Dark blue or white sports socks. ➤ Sports trainers (appropriate for physical activity). ➤ Slide-in shin pads & Gum shields (for hockey). ➤ Dance – 'Q' tracksuit bottoms/ 'Q' leggings and 'Q' polo top, no shorts or skorts to be worn for Dance. ➤ OPTIONAL - Long-sleeved 'Q' logo top. |
| <p>D and T</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Navy blue apron |
| <p>Equipment for every lesson</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ School bag – suitable to carry up to A4 folders/books. ➤ Pencil case – containing BLUE, BLACK, GREEN pens. Pencils, sharpener, eraser and ruler. ➤ Calculator – scientific one (<i>can be purchased via ParentPay</i>). ➤ Glue stick and highlighters one (<i>can be purchased via ParentPay</i>). |
| <p>Basic standards and expectations</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Mobile phones must not be seen on site. ➤ Natural hair colour and natural make up. ➤ One flat ring and one pair of stud earrings. ➤ No nose studs, cartilage, or facial piercings. ➤ No smart watches. ➤ No hoodies or sportswear to be worn around school. |
