We have seen large numbers of recognition points awarded this week. Keep up the good work! 9SWI are at the top of the Year 9 Recognition Board for the second week in a row!

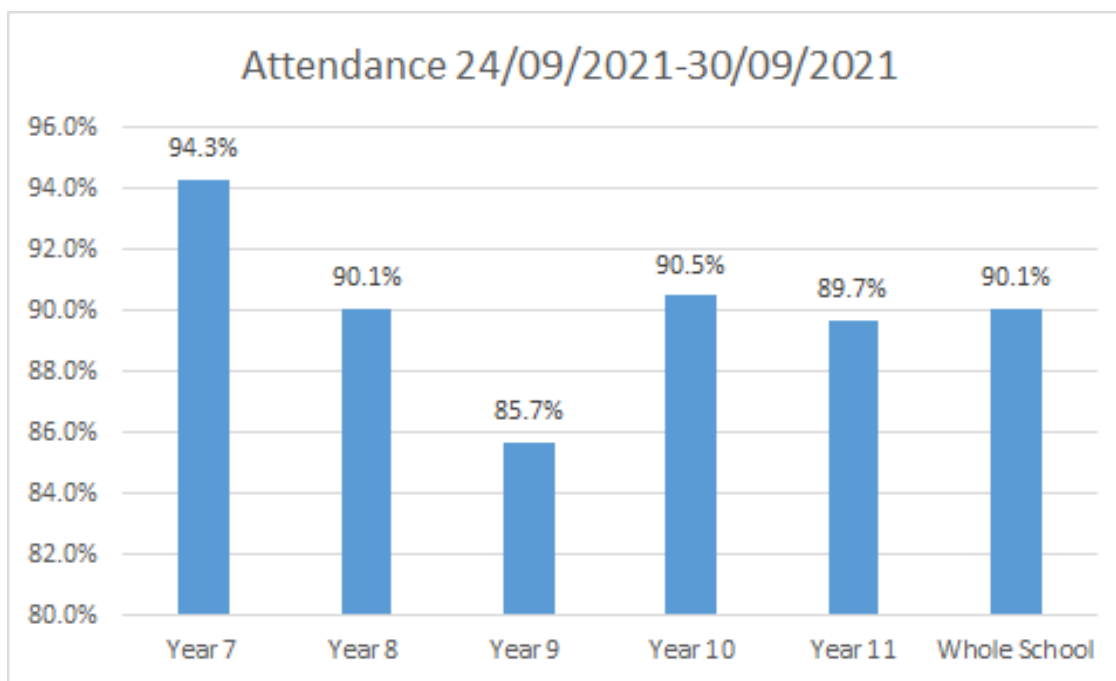
