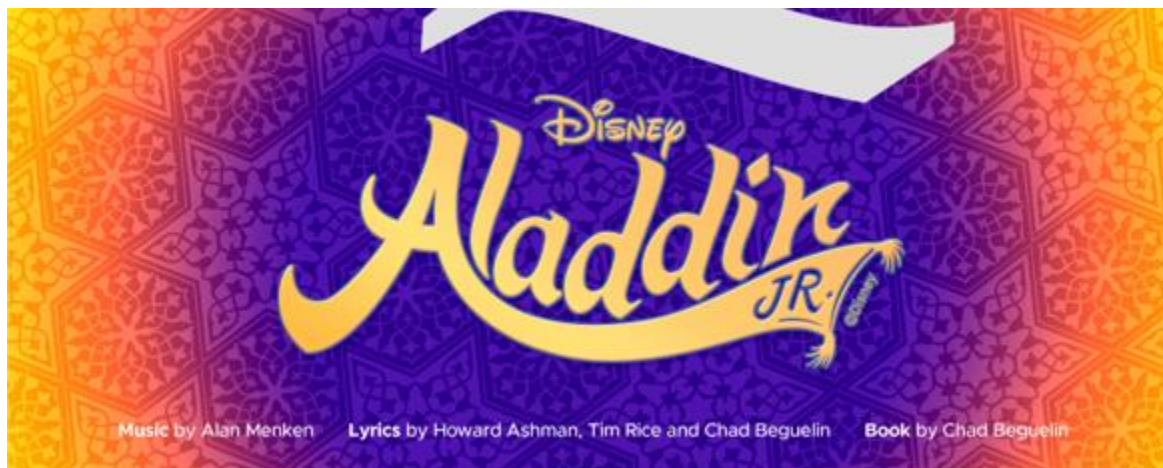




Queensbridge Connect

6pm-10pm Saturday and Sunday

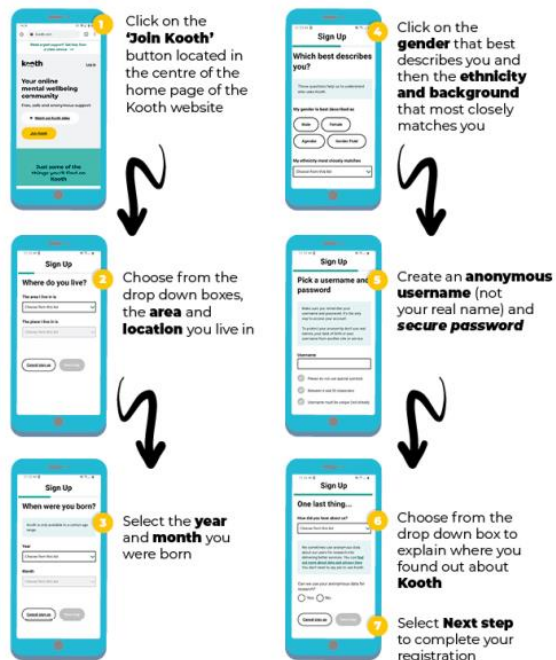
Log on through **mobile, laptop and tablet.**
